

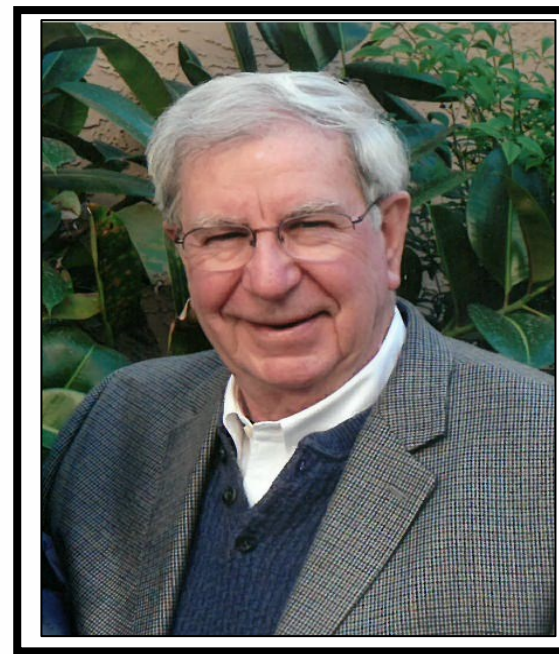
LOVE
